

Workaround for Microsoft Vista

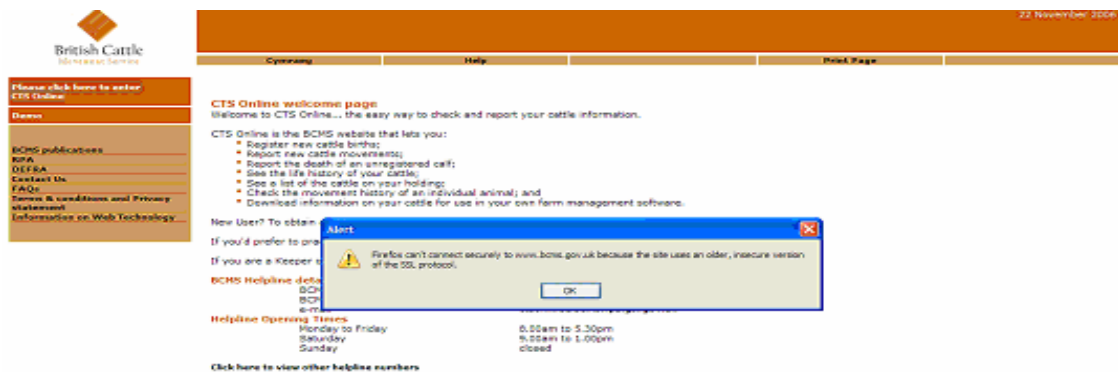
If you have problems logging onto CTS Online using Microsoft Vista, please download the Firefox 2 browser and follow the steps below.

You can download Firefox 2 from the following web address:

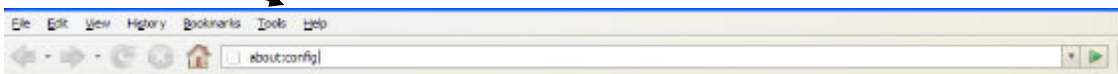

Once you have finished downloading Firefox 2, type in the web address for CTS Online, which is www.bcms.gov.uk. CTS Online is not yet compliant with the latest security standards, so generates the warning seen below. However, once you have followed the steps below you will be able to access CTS Online through Firefox without problem. Access through Firefox2 provides the same level of security as CTS Online always had, and we hope that you continue to use it.

You should receive an error message in as seen below.



Type the words **about:config** in the address bar as shown below and press *enter*. (**CARE** – When downloading Firefox 2 a Google search box may be added to the Menu – please make sure that you do not use this to carry out this exercise.)



A long list of options will be displayed on your screen as shown below.

In the filter field type: **ssl2** and press **enter**. This can also be entered as **SSL2** and will give the same results.

Seven entries will appear on your screen as shown below:

Double click each entry so the value is **true** as shown below:

In the address bar you can now overwrite the entry **about:config** with the name of our web site - **www.bcms.gov.uk**
